All girls will receive schedules, rules and rosters at 5:30 pm Wednesday, July 3, at the field.

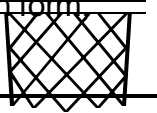

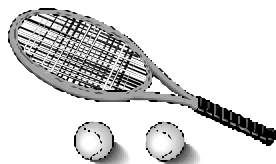

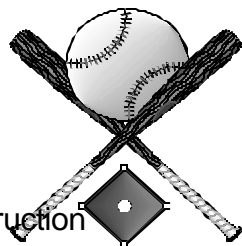
