NURSING II/LPN ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Academic Requirements:

- New, Transfer, Readmit and Seeking 2nd SUNY Orange Degree Students ONLY:* Must have a current college application on file
- Submit official High School Transcript or GED
- Completed Freshman English 1 (ENG 101)
- Eligible to take Intermediate Algebra (MAT 102) or have successfully completed Elementary Algebra (MAT 101), or equivalent, with a "C" or higher
- Completed Anatomy & Physiology I (BIO 111) with a grade of "C" or higher within 5 years of application deadline
- Completed Microbiology (MLT 106) with a grade of "C" or higher within 5 years of application deadline
- Completed High School Regents (New York State) course or College Prep Chemistry course with a grade of 75 or higher, passing grade on the Chemistry CLEP examination (**no credit will be given, but will count towards meeting admissions criteria**), or a college Chemistry course (with a lab), all with a grade of "C" or higher and all within 10 years of the application deadline
- Students must attain a minimum program GPA of 2.75

Department Specific Requirements:

- Official LPN Program transcript submitted to Office of Admissions
- Proof of licensure submitted to Office of Admissions
- Meet the criteria for articulation transfer** or receive a "B" on the Excelsior College Examination for Fundamentals of Nursing. (Refer to our website for more information: www.sunyorange.edu/nursing/ed_mobility.shtml)
- Completion of the Test of Essential Academic Skills (RN ATI TEAS/ RN TEAS VI) within 2 years of the application deadline. Must achieve a minimum level of BASIC for admission consideration.
- Successful completion of the SUNY Orange Nursing Bridge 1 course (N3029). Students will be contacted by the Nursing department regarding approval to register for this course.
- Grade of 90% on Clinical Calculations Skill Examination Level 1 (to be given at the conclusion of the Nursing Bridge course). Satisfactory skills performances (to be evaluated during Nursing Bridge Course).

Selection Process:

Students will be considered for admission into Nursing II based on the completion of all mandatory eligibility requirements, highest combination of program GPA, TEAS score, and seats available.

All Nursing Academic and Department Specific Requirements must be completed by the following dates in order to be considered for acceptance: June 1st (Newburgh campus programs) or October 1st (Middletown campus program)

Please note that the Nursing Bridge 1 course is invitation only from the Nursing department. Students who meet all admissions requirements will be contacted regarding dates and times for this course if eligible to take the course.

Below is a list of non-clinical courses for the LPN to RN/Nursing II program. Although not admission requirements, the courses below are strongly recommended.

****Note:** To meet the articulation agreement, a student must have graduated from Orange – Ulster or Ulster BOCES LPN Program within 5 years of program entry attaining a grade of 85 or higher.
