How to drop off a question in NetTutor

You've clicked on NetTutor from your My.SUNYOrange.edu page, and you've selected a subject from the list. You want to drop off a question and receive feedback, so what's next?

1. To begin, click on the option to **Drop Off a Question** under the subject you've selected.



Proceed to Question Entry. This will send you to the NetTutor whiteboard.

3. Using the whiteboard, select from the text tools on the left-hand navigation to type your question, show your homework problem, and any work or initial thoughts related to solving the problem. When you're done, click on the yellow **Submit** button on the bottom left.

They'll guide you through the process of solving a problem and understanding the work, but the tutor will not provide the answer for you. It is up to you to arrive at the answer yourself using the tutor's guidance. When in doubt, ask your instructor any questions directly!

6. Click on your question (the title you gave it in the beginning) and select the option to download the tutor's feedback as a PDF or view the feedback inside of your browser.
