The Bureau of Labor Statistics reports that nearly 60 percent of emergency management specialists nationally have attained, at minimum, an associate's degree and many have also gained experience in a related field prior to becoming emergency management specialists.



Why Emergency Management?

Demand for emergency management specialists alone is expected to grow by 21.6 percent by 2018, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics. Top employers of emergency management specialists are local governments, state governments, general medical and surgical hospitals, power generation and supply services, and emergency and other relief agencies. Their efforts are critical to homeland security because they help people, businesses and communities avoid and better react to crises.
