Selection Process:

- Students will be considered for admission into this program based on the completion of all academic and department-specific pre-admission requirements, ATI TEAS results and selected according to their ranking based on the highest combination of program GPA and credits completed towards the degree (see below). Selection will also be based on seat availability.
- The Office of Admissions will include all of your pre-requisite courses, in which you receive a "C" (2.00) or higher, in the program GPA calculation and credit review process.

Satisfactory skills performances (to be evaluated during Nursing Bridge Course).

All of the above Academic and Department requirements must be completed *on or before May 1st* in order for a student to be considered for acceptance into the program for the fall semester in Newburgh or *on or before October 1st* for acceptance into the program for the spring semester in Middletown
