### **Department Specific Requirements:**

Attendance at a Dental Hygiene pre-admission seminar within 3 years of the application deadline. At this seminar, students will receive and sign off on information pertaining to health forms, drug testing, and criminal record policies.

Submit Dental Hygienist Observation Form (16 hour minimum with documentation) within 3 years of the application deadline.

#### **Selection Process:**

Students will be considered for admission into this program based on the completion of all academic and department specific requirements, highest combination of cumulative GPA and credits completed towards the program (see below), and seats available.

All Dental Hygiene Academic and Department Specific Requirements must be completed by  $\underline{\text{February } 1^{\text{st}}}$  in order for a student to be considered for acceptance into the program for the fall semester.

Though not admissions requirements, completing the courses below will enhance your admission eligibility (27 credits total):
