NURSING ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Academic Requirements:

- ☐ *New and Transfer Students ONLY:* Must have a current college application on file
- ☐ High School Diploma or GED
- ☐ Eligible to take Freshman English 1 (ENG 101)
- ☐ Eligible to take Intermediate Algebra (MAT 102) or have successfully completed Elementary Algebra (MAT 101), or equivalent, with a "C" or higher
- ☐ Completed **one or more** of the following:

- Intro to Biology (BIO 110)
 - General Biology I (BIO 101) **and** General Biology II (BIO 102)
 - Anatomy & Physiology I (BIO 111)
 - Anatomy & Physiology II (BIO 112)

 - Passing grade on the Biology CLEP examination
 - High School AP Biology (score of 3 or higher) – submit the official AP transcript from College Board
- ☐ Completed High School Regents (New York State) course or College Prep Chemistry course with a grade of 75 or higher, passing grade on the Chemistry CLEP examination (no **credit will be given, but will count towards meeting admissions criteria**), or a college Chemistry course (with a lab), all with a grade of "C" or higher and all within 10 years of the application deadline
- ☐ Students must attain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75

Department Specific Requirements:

- ☐ Applicants for the Nursing program will be required to take the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) prior to the deadline. You must achieve a minimum ATI Academic Preparedness Level of BASIC for admission consideration. Students who place higher will receive stronger consideration. Students will be considered for admission into this program based on the completion of all academic and department specific requirements, highest combination of cumulative GPA, TEAS score, and credits completed towards the program (see below), and seats available.

All Nursing Academic and Department Specific Requirements must be completed by February 1st in order for a student to be considered for acceptance into the program for the fall semester.
