- ☐ Submit Occupational Therapy Assistant Observation Form with essay (15 hour minimum with documentation) within 3 years of the application deadline.

#### **Selection Process:**

Students will be considered for admission into this program based on the completion of all academic and department specific requirements. The Occupational Therapy Assistant Department reviews all identified eligible students. The Department selects candidates using the highest combination of cumulative GPA, quality of essay and interview.

All Occupational Therapy Assistant Academic and Department Specific Requirements must be completed by February 1st in order for a student to be considered for acceptance into the program for the fall semester.
