PHYSICAL THERAPIST ASSISTANT ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Academic Requirements:

- ✓ New and Transfer Students ONLY: Must have a current college application on file
- ← High School Diploma or GED
- ← Eligible to take Freshman English 1 (ENG 101)
- Eligible to take Elementary Algebra (MAT 101), or equivalent, with a "C" or higher, or have successfully completed Developmental Algebra (MAT 020)
- ✓ Completed one or more of the following within 5 years of the application deadline:
 - Intro to Biology (BIO 110)
 - General Biology I (BIO 101) and General Biology II (BIO 102)

all must be with a grade of "C" or higher

- Anatomy & Physiology I (BIO 111)
- Anatomy & Physiology II (BIO 112)
- Passing grade on the Biology CLEP examination
- High School AP Biology (score of 3 or higher) submit the official AP transcript from College Board
- ✓ Students must attain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0

Department Specific Requirements:

- Completion of an online Physical Therapist Assistant pre-admission seminar and follow-up interview with Department Chair within 3 years of the application deadline. At this follow-up interview, students will receive and sign off on information pertaining to health forms, drug testing, and criminal record policies. - Submit Physical Therapist Assistant Observation Form with essay (16 hour minimum with documentation) within 3 years of the application deadline.

Selection Process:

Students will be considered for admission into this program based on the completion of all academic and department specific requirements. The Physical Therapist Assistant Department reviews all identified eligible students. The Department selects candidates using the highest combination of cumulative GPA, quality of essay and interview.

All Physical Therapist Assistant Academic and Department Specific Requirements must be completed by $\underline{\text{February } 1^{\text{st}}}$ in order for a student to be considered for acceptance into the program for the fall semester.
