Selection Process:

Students will be considered for admission into Nursing II based on the completion of all mandatory eligibility requirements, highest combination of cumulative GPA, TEAS score, and seats available.

All admissions requirements must be completed by October 1st (except for successful completion of the Nursing Bridge 1 course. Students who meet all admissions requirements will be contacted regarding dates and times for this course).
