### Admissions Requirements

#### Academic Requirements:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Submit an online health profession application to the program at [https://sunyorange.edu/admissions/health\\_professions](https://sunyorange.edu/admissions/health_professions)  
*\*\*Please note that this application will serve as a general application to the College as well as the Nursing program\*\**
- \_\_\_\_\_ Submit official high school transcript; or GED with score report
- \_\_\_\_\_ Submit official college transcripts (if applicable)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Eligible to take ENG 101
- \_\_\_\_\_ Eligible to take MAT 102; or have completed MAT 101 or equiv. with a 2.00/“C” or higher
- \_\_\_\_\_ Completion of at least one of the following: BIO110; BIO 101 **and** BIO 102; BIO 111; or BIO 112 with a 2.00/“C” or higher; AP Biology (score of 3, 4, or 5); or a passing grade on the Biology CLEP exam.  
*Note: Per the Nursing Department, if BIO 112 is taken within 5 years of the application deadline, and BIO 111 is outside of the 5-year timeframe, BIO 111 will be counted in the review process.*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Completion of one of the following within 10 years of application deadline: HS Regents Chemistry course or equiv. with a grade of 75 or higher; AP Chemistry (score of 3, 4 or 5); CHM 100 (formerly CHM 120) or another college Chemistry w/lab with a grade of 2.00/“C” or higher; or a passing grade on the Chemistry I CLEP exam.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Minimum program GPA of 2.75 within required/recommended courses for application (except HS Chemistry Regents course).

#### Department-Specific Requirements:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Take the ATI TEAS Exam within 2 years of application deadline, and obtain a minimum score level of BASIC (Proficient or higher is recommended). Students who obtain a higher score will receive stronger consideration. To review FAQs, and information about payment and scheduling the TEAS Exam, visit <https://sunyorange.edu/testing/teas.html>
- \_\_\_\_\_ Complete a Nursing pre-admission seminar online (valid for 2 years) to receive information about health forms, program standards, and criminal record & drug screening policies.  
*Note: The Nursing Department will review transcripts of those students who have been enrolled in and did not complete a nursing program at SUNY Orange or another college.*

#### Selection Process:

- Submit online application by **February 1 (Middletown)** or **October 1 (Newburgh)**.
- Applicants will be considered based on the total amount of non-clinical courses complete (please see below), program GPA, Science GPA and TEAS exam results. For the Nursing Program, the following courses will be calculated in the Science GPA review: BIO 111, BIO 112 & MLT 106.
- The Office of Admissions will include all of your pre-requisite courses, in which you receive a “C” (2.00) or higher, in the program GPA calculation and credit review process.

**All of the above Academic and Department requirements must be completed on or before February 1<sup>st</sup> in order for a student to be considered for acceptance into the program for the fall semester in Middletown or on or before October 1<sup>st</sup> for acceptance into the program for the spring semester in Newburgh.
