- Applicants will be considered based on the completion of all academic, department, and application requirements, the the total number of non-clinical program credits completed (see table above), program GPA and science GPA. For Physical Therapist Assistant, the following courses will be calculated in the science GPA: BIO 111 and BIO 112.
