

Financial Aid Checklist

1. Create an FSA ID and Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

Visit the <u>FAFSA</u> website to apply for the **2024-2025** FAFSA

- If you are considered a dependent student by FAFSA, your parent(s) must create an FSA ID as well.
 This serves as your electronic signature. Make sure both you and your parent (if required) sign the FAFSA or it will be rejected.
- ✓ The FAFSA is available every year on October 1st for the next academic year, and you must file it every year.
- ✓ The FAFSA Federal School Code for SUNY Orange is <u>002876</u>.
- ✓ SUNY Orange Financial Aid will process your FAFSA information and you will receive an award notification letter.
- ✓ Please visit your MySUNYOrange frequently to see if more documentation is needed to complete your financial aid file.

Helpful Hints:

- ✓ If your parent(s) do not have Social Security Number(s), enter all zeroes (000-00-0000) in the Social Security Number field(s) for parent(s) on the FAFSA. Anytime all zeroes are entered for parent(s), the FAFSA signature page must be printed, signed and mailed to the FAFSA processor.
- ✓ If you're not sure who to list as your parent(s) on the FAFSA, <u>click here</u> to learn more.
- ✓ If you are homeless, an unaccompanied youth, ward of the court or have other circumstances where you cannot provide parental information on the FAFSA, please contact the SUNY Orange Financial Aid Office for assistance completing the FAFSA.

2. Apply for NYS Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) and NYS Excelsior Scholarship (Excelsior)

- ✓ After completing the FAFSA, you will be instructed to complete your "State Aid Application." If you miss the link, an EXPRESS TAP APPLICATION will be emailed to you or you can visit HESC.ny.gov.
- ✓ The NYS TAP/EXCELSIOR School Code for SUNY Orange is 2125.
- ✓ The FAFSA and NYS TAP applications <u>must</u> be completed to be considered for the Excelsior Scholarship.
- ✓ You must be a NYS resident attending full time (12+ credits) and registered in courses applicable to your degree.
- ✓ Students attending Part Time may be eligible for **Part Time TAP** (PTAP) or **Aid to Part Time Study** (APTS). Click here to learn more.

3. Complete Federal Verification

6. Register for "Applicable" Courses in your Degree

- Federal and State financial aid programs will only cover courses that are required to complete your declared degree. Enrolling in courses that don't pertain to your degree may impact (lower) your financial aid eligibility.
