What Is Degree Works? Tutorial Transcript

You can access DegreeWorks from your MySUNYOrange at the top right corner of the page. DegreeWorks is a web-based tool that will allow you to track your requirements, prepare for your advising meetings, and plan for graduation. Your **DegreeWorks Worksheet** is continuously updated to reflect any changes to your academic record such as: grades that you earned, courses that you completed, courses that you are taking, transfer credits, and course substitutions

Note: If you are a Pre-Health student *or in the Liberal Arts program*, please refer to the Advising Worksheets located in your Student Services/Resources page on the side bar menu in the Academic Advising and Career Planning box.

Before you begin, make sure to review your DegreeWorks worksheet along with your program sheet located in the Online College Catalog. The College Catalog is located under your Student Services/Resources page in the "Policies and Publications" box. Click on "Academic Degrees and programs"; scroll down the list of programs and locate yours. They are listed in alphabetical order. Your program sheet provides the recommended order in which you should take your classes. Make sure to refer to the program sheet in the catalog year when you started your program; previous versions of your program sheet are available on the Catalog Archive menu.
