

SUNY ORANGE BRIDGES Program

BRIDGES is an individualized, inclusive, community-based postsecondary education experience for students with developmental disabilities who are over the age of 21 or who have graduated from high school and who wish to continue their education in an integrated collegiate environment. The Program is designed to teach skills and strategies in a supported environment that enable students to transition to successful and independent lives. The Program's overall goal is to offer students education beyond high school that focuses on employment, independent living, academics and lifelong learning, personal development, and social participation.

The BRIDGES Program currently will consist of 36 courses leading to a Certificate of Higher Education. Of the 36 courses, 28 courses are required BRIDGES course content and 8 courses are elective/audit college courses requirements. A Certificate of Higher Education will be awarded students, who complete the requisite curriculum within a maximum of six semesters, at SUNY Orange's Graduation Ceremony.
