Best Practice on Standard 5: The Board of Commissioners applauds the Institution for Emergency Preparedness Systems that are in place (cardiac defibrillator installations) for the safety and welfare of faculty, students and stakeholders.

Place an OFI on Standard 5: The board appreciates the work involved in completing Table 3a: Faculty and Staff Results (Standard 5). However, please provide evidence in the next QA Report on the results of the Creation of a Center for Teaching and Learning based on the % decreases from 2017 - 98% to 2018 - 94%.
