Meet Title IX Coordinators Iris Martinez-Davis and Madeline Torres-Diaz. This is an opportunity to meet with the Title IX Coordinators and discuss common myths regarding Title IX. Title IX is the federal law that prohibits sex discrimination in any academic or athletic program in a federally funded school and requires schools to respond to knowledge and reports of sex discrimination in particular ways. Sex discrimination includes sexual harassment and sexual violence such as sexual assault, rape, stalking, dating violence and intimate partner violence. Title IX protects any person from sex/gender-based discrimination, including students, faculty and staff; women and men; and individuals who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual and/or transgender.

The coordinators are responsible for monitoring and oversight of the overall implementation of Title IX Compliance at the College, including coordination of training, education, communications, and administration of complaint procedures for employees, students, and other College community members.
