-spoke about how being in senate is a learning experience, using skills acquired while on senate in real world. Started Unity Day and committee.

- 1. President's report:
- a. Dr. Iannuzzi:
 - Needs help from senate obtaining info for survey regarding daytime scheduled students. Wants senate to go over questions and give feedback. Asked if she could attend the next senate meeting, as President Young will be at next NSS meeting (Nov. 2nd), Bolaji invited her to NSS meeting on November 9th.

- b. China Trip
 - Vinny came to Newburgh to follow up on things and is urging us to spend more money
 - China Trip: Paul Basinski is giving 12 students an opportunity to travel to China as an educational experience. He asked if NSS could help with \$3,000 per student for the trip, from student funds. Newburgh students were not given enough or any notice, and as far as we know at this time, were not given the opportunity to be part of the trip. All spots are presumably filled already.
