ACADEMIC SUPPORT - The Tutorial/Learning Center

Scheduled tutoring options, such as small group, one-on-one or paired sessions, are offered by appointment in the Tutorial Center located on the second floor of the library in Middletown and in the Learning Center in Kaplan Hall, room 220 on the Newburgh Campus. All credit students of the College may request scheduled tutoring for a course in which they are currently enrolled. In order to receive this type of academic support, you must fill out the Academic Support Application. Scheduling is arranged through the Tutorial Center or Learning Center, depending on the campus you prefer, and depends on a match between tutor availability and your availability. Students do homework assignments before attending sessions with the tutor and an attendance policy is in place for scheduled tutoring.

Students may download the Academic Support Application via the Students Services/Resources tab on MySUNYOrange under Academic Support Center. Follow the steps outlined. The application only needs to be completed once, regardless of the number of support options requested.

Another valuable service offered is tutoring in the academic department labs. Students who are struggling with homework, or have questions about subjects and want to stop in for a few minutes for assistance can easily do so, in our math lab, diagnostic imaging, nursing lab or Batcavern. Hours for these labs are posted on the Academic Support webpage. Our reading and writing labs are available for student use through sign-up sheets located on site.
