

#### TIME COMMITMENT

February 2007: Initial introductory/pairing meeting (2 hours).

**May:** Present project and findings. Post strategies and lessons online (3 hours).

**September:** Fully implement projects and assessment strategies.

**November 2007:** Share findings with the College and the High School colleagues. Information will also be posted online (6 hours).
