Faculty in Residence will be committed to excellence in teaching. Responsibilities will include the design and implementation of one or more of the following projects: 1) a Faculty Learning Community or Action Research Group, 2) a Workshop Series, 3) a Directory of Faculty Expertise in Teaching, or 4) a Summer Institute in College Teaching. Alternative projects proposed by the Faculty in Residence are also encouraged. The Faculty in Residence will participate in the CTL Advisory Group, help facilitate other CTL initiatives and work closely with the CTL coordinator to continue development of the CTL. This position reports to the Coordinator of the CTL.
