



Target Dates for Federal Financial Aid Processing

PELL GRANTS / DIRECT LOANS / CAMPUS-BASED AID

Target dates are not deadlines; they are dates which will ensure that Financial Aid funds for which you may be eligible are applied to your account for tuition deferment before the payment due date. Financial Aid applications can still be processed after these dates; however, you need to make arrangements with Student Services Central for an alternative means of payment until your financial aid is processed.

The electronic Student Aid Report, which is the result of your completing the FAFSA, admission application, immunization records, major declaration, high school transcript(s), etc. – need to be on file in the appropriate offices by the target date for financial aid processing.

If you are selected by the federal government for verification, you will be asked to submit additional documentation such as a verification worksheet, federal tax transcripts, W-2's, etc. You will be notified via your MySUNYOrange on the Student Finances tab if you have outstanding requirements. This information should be submitted to the Financial Aid office before the target date.

TARGET DATES:

- **Pell Grant and Direct Loans**
 - Summer Enrollees: June 1
 - Fall Enrollees: July 1
 - Spring Enrollees: December 1
- **Campus Based Aid (Includes Federal Work Study and Supplemental Educational Opportunity (SEOG) Grants**
 - Fall Enrollees: April 15
 - Spring Enrollees: Not applicable
