Subject: Fall 2004 Enrollment Report

Attached are the tables summarizing Fall 2004 enrollment. Details include:

- \* Total headcount is 6,269, an increase of 2.6% over last year and a new school record.
- \* AAFTE at 2,014 is an increase of 4.2% over Fall 2003 and is a new record.
- \* Full-time day and evening students at 3,222 versus 3,011 last year is also a school record.
- \* By location, Middletown accounted for 82.4% of credit FTE, Newburgh 12.2%, OCCC in the high school 3.9%, and other locations 1.5%.
- \* There are 1,097 students taking at least one course at Newburgh versus 1,046 last Fall.
- \* Day students accounted for 73.4% of all AAFTE's, Evening 26.6%
- \* Total minority population increased from the Fall of 2003 to 24.7% of total population, a gain of .7%. Percentage of African-American students gained .4% to 9.6%. Hispanic students climbed to 12.3% from 11.8%. This trend is reflected in the demographic information used in planning. This trend should continue over the next ten years.
- \* First time students at 1712 is an increase of 10.3% over Fall 2003. Continuing students at 3,099 is a decrease of .2%. Returning students at 664 was an increase of 4.6%. Transfer students at 259 is a decrease of 52 over last year.
- \* Females account for 61.3% of students on campus.
- \* The rate of retention from Spring 04 to Fall 04 is 63.3%, last year it was 63.2%.
