Subject: Spring 2005 Enrollment Report

Attached is the data summarizing Spring 2005 enrollment. Highlights include:

- Current enrollment (headcount) at 5,632 is a decrease of .1% over Spring 2004. Full-time enrollment is up 5.8% and part-time enrollment is down 5.4%.
- FTE's at 1794.1 is an increase of 35.1 FTE's, a 2.0% increase over Spring 2004.
- Newburgh recorded a minor FTE decrease of .2% going from 217.8 to 217.3 FTE.
- Retention was 70.1% from Fall 2003 to Spring 2004 an increase from 69.7% from Fall 2002 to Spring 2003.
- Hispanic population is now at 12.4%, when just six years ago it was at 8.8%, making it the number one minority population at the college.
- 62.3% of total enrollment is female consistent with the last few years.
- The average age of a full-time student is 19 and of a part-time student is 24.
- Orange County residents account for 84.7% of total enrollment with Sullivan residents at 5.3% and Ulster residents at 4.2%
- The Associate in Science majors (typical transfer degrees), have shown growth up 1.8% in both the spring of 2004and 2005, after the large14.9% increase in Spring 2003.
