Why? This is the first lecture in the **Global Initiative: Asia** series at SUNY-Orange for the academic year 2010-2011. **Professor Strmiska** will provide a wide-ranging discussion of various aspects of Asian culture, including Asian forms of art, education, religion and economy, showing threads that link together the ancient past with the hyper-modern present. Dr. Strmiska lived in Japan from 1999-2004 and has wide knowledge of Asian religion, culture and history.
