NURSING II/LPN ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Academic Requirements:
New, Transfer, Readmit and Seeking 2 nd SUNY Orange Degree Students ONLY: Must have a current college application on file
Submit official High School Transcript or GED
Completed Freshman English 1 (ENG 101)
Eligible to take Intermediate Algebra (MAT 102) or have successfully completed Elementary Algebra (MAT 101), or equivalen with a "C" or higher
Completed Anatomy & Physiology I (BIO 111) with a grade of "C" or higher within 5 years of application deadline
Completed Microbiology (MLT 106) with a grade of "C" or higher within 5 years of application deadline
Completed High School Regents (New York State) course or College Prep Chemistry course with a grade of 75 or higher, passing grade on the Chemistry CLEP examination (no credit will be given, but will count towards meeting admissions criteria), a college Chemistry course (with a lab), all with a grade of "C" or higher and all within 10 years of the application deadline Students must attain a minimum program GPA of 2.75
Department Specific Requirements:
Submit official LPN Program transcript
Submit proof of licensure
Meet the criteria for articulation transfer** or receive a "B" on the Excelsior College Examination for Fundamentals of Nursing (Refer to our website for more information: www.sunyorange.edu/nursing/ed_mobility.shtml)
Take the ATI TEAS exam within 2 years of application deadline, and obtain a minimum score level of BASIC. Students who obtain a higher score will receive stronger consideration. Complete a Nursing Online Pre-Admission Seminar and submit certificate of completion to Student Services Central.
After applying, students may be contacted by the Nursing Department to complete the following requirements:
Successful completion of the SUNY Orange Nursing Bridge course (N3029). Students will be contacted by the Nursin
department regarding registration for this course if accepted to the LPN to RN Program.

Selection Process:

• Students will be considered for admission into this program based on the completion of all academic and department-specific pre-admission requirements, and selected according to their ranking based on the highest combination of ATI TEAS results, program GPA and credits completed towards the degree (see below). Selection will also be based on seat availability.

Grade of 90% on Clinical Calculations Skill Examination Level 1 (to be given at the conclusion of the Nursing Bridge course).

Satisfactory skills performances (to be evaluated during Nursing Bridge Course).

• The Office of Admissions will include all of your pre-requisite courses, in which you receive a "C" (2.00) or higher, in the program GPA calculation and credit review process.

All of the above Academic and Department requirements must be completed on or before May 1st in order for a student to be considered for acceptance into the program for the fall semester in Newburgh or on or before October 1st for acceptance into the program for the spring semester in Middletown

Below is a list of additional non-clinical courses for the program in addition to the courses listed above. Although not required to be complete prior to admission, the courses below are required for the program.
