Admissions Requirements

Academic Requirements:

- High School diploma or GED
- Have a completed college application on file in admissions department including all college transcripts.
- Eligible to take Freshman English I (ENG 101).
- Eligible to take Intermediate Algebra (MAT 102) or equivalent, or have completed Elementary Algebra (MAT 101) with a 2.0 or higher.
- Completed Anatomy & Physiology I (BIO 111) & Microbiology (MLT 106) with a grade of 2.0 or better (within 5 years of program start date).
- Minimum GPA of 2.75

Department Specific Requirements:

- Official LPN Program transcript and proof of licensure must be submitted to Admissions Office
- Meet the criteria for articulation transfer or receive a B on the Excelsior College Examination for Fundamentals of Nursing. (Refer to our website for more information - www.sunyorange.edu/nursing/ed_mobility.shtml)
- Completion of the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS). Must achieve a minimum of a Basic score for admission consideration.
- Successful completion of the SUNY Orange Nursing Bridge 1 course (N3029). Students will be contacted by June 30th regarding approval to register for this course.
- Grade of 90% on Clinical Calculations Skill Examination Level 1 (to be given at the conclusion of the Nursing Bridge Course 1).
- Satisfactory skills performance (to be evaluated during Nursing Bridge Course 1)

Selection Process

Students will be considered for admission into Nursing II based on the completion of all mandatory eligibility requirements, highest combination of cumulative GPA, TEAS score and credits completed towards the program (see reverse), Orange County residency, and seat availability. Students must meet all of the above requirements to be considered for admission.

*All admissions requirements must be **completed by June 1st** (except for successful completion of the Nursing Bridge 1 course. Students who meet all admissions requirements will be contacted regarding dates and times for this course) in order for a student to be considered for admission into Nursing II for the fall semester.*
