Admissions Requirements

Academic Requirements:

- High School diploma or GED.
- Completed Freshman English I (ENG 101) or equivalent.
- Eligible to take Intermediate Algebra (MAT 102) or equivalent, or have completed Elementary Algebra (MAT 101) with a 2.0 or higher.
- Completed Anatomy & Physiology I (BIO 111) & Microbiology (MLT 106) with a grade of 2.0 or better. (Within 5 years of applying).
- Minimum GPA of 2.5

Department Specific Requirements:

- Successful completion of the SUNY Orange Nursing Bridge Course 1 (N3029). Students may register for the course once they have submitted this eligibility form.
- Grade of 80% on Clinical Calculations Skill Examination Level 1 (to be given at the conclusion of the Nursing Bridge Course 1).
- Official LPN Program transcript and proof of licensure must be submitted to Admissions Office
- Meet the criteria for articulation transfer or receive a B on the Excelsior College Examination for Fundamentals of Nursing.

Applicants for the Nursing program will be required to take the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS). Students may be required to take remedial courses in Nursing based on test results. Test times will be announced.

Selection Process

Students will be considered for admission into Nursing II based on the completion of all mandatory eligibility requirements, highest combination of cumulative GPA and credits completed towards the program (see reverse), Orange County residency, and seat availability. Students must meet all of the above requirements to be considered for admission.

All admissions requirements must be completed by November 1st in order for a student to be considered for admission into Nursing II for the spring semester. Courses taken and completed in the fall semester will be considered only if seats are still available at the conclusion of the initial applicant review in November.
