Goal #1: Identify and reduce the barriers to academic and personal success

- 1. Build a network of support services that align personal well-being (such as childcare, transportation, housing or food insecurity, etc) with academic learning
- 2. Enhance ongoing and continuous connections between students and their advisors from entry to graduation
- 3. Continue to provide accelerated learning opportunities for students who are underprepared for degree pathways



Goal #2: Provide personalized resources and guidance to ensure student readiness to succeed at SUNY Orange

- 1. Create and implement a guided first-year experience that addresses self-efficacy, college readiness and a sense of belonging within the SUNY Orange community
- 2. Provide mentorship opportunities to better connect students to the college community through multiple touchpoints
- 3. Integrate career and transfer guidance throughout the student curricular and co-curricular experience



Goal #3: Increase program flexibility for the students of today and tomorrow

- 1. Create program maps for part-time students
- 2. Strengthen resources and technologies for online learning
- 3. Create long term course sequencing for on-campus and online learners



Goal #4: Create accessible pipelines between non-degree, degree, and certificate programs

- 1. Provide targeted placement measures for historically underserved students, creating multiple pathways/flexible schedule options to program completion
- 2. Bridge ESL/HSE students to the college community in order to facilitate equitable transition to and persistence in college and certificate programs
- 3. Provide opportunities for current students who are dual-enrolled (such as P-Tech, CCHS) and those who are enrolled in non-degree programs (such as BRIDGES, LPP) to progress into degree programs

- 1. Identify and respond to evolving business, industry and cultural trends, and community needs

- 4. Provide short term credentials aligned with workforce needs to increase career ladder progression and degree completion

- 2. Utilize pathway designers and certificate coordinators to facilitate the training process
- 3. Increase and strengthen school-to-work programming opportunities
