

**Program Articulation Agreement between
Adelphi University
And
Orange County Community College**

1. Purpose

This agreement between Adelphi University and Orange County Community College provides the terms and conditions for students of Orange County Community College who have an Associate Applied Science in Nursing and seek admission by transfer to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing at Adelphi University. The parties will use their best efforts to minimize loss of credits and duplication of coursework.

2. Admission

Orange County Community College graduates are required to meet the minimum criteria for admission to Adelphi University. At this time, the School of Nursing requires for:

- Non-RN Transfers: minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 and successful passing of the required Nursing entrance exam; science prerequisite grades of a C+ or better
- RN's: minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8 and valid NYS Nursing License

Applicants whose GPA falls below a 2.8 but above a 2.0 will be given individual consideration on a case-by-case basis.

3. Transfer of Credits

Orange County Community College students will be eligible to receive up to a maximum of 64 transfer credits at Adelphi University. Only courses completed with a grade of "C-" or higher will be accepted in transfer to the University.

4. Scholarships

Academic scholarships range from \$1,500 to \$10,000 plus, based on cumulative G.P.A. and full-time study (part-time scholarships are also available). The minimum cumulative G.P.A. required for an academic scholarship is a 3.0. Need-based financial aid is also available to those who qualify. Priority filing date for Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is February 15 for fall applicants and October 15 for spring applicants.

5. Terms of Agreement

This agreement becomes effective on the date of signature by representatives of the institutions reflected below. The terms of this agreement may be modified or terminated at any time upon the mutual consent of both institutions with appropriate notification. In the event it is decided at any time to modify or terminate this agreement, commitments made to individual students already in the program will continue in effect in the terms applicable at the time the student enrolled in the program.


