## **ALGEBRA COMPETENCY STATEMENT**

Franklin University requires that all of our students satisfy an Algebra Competency Requirement. The Algebra Competency Requirement can be met in the following ways:

- 1. Algebra II in High School with a grade of "C" or higher;
- 2. Pass the Franklin University Algebra Competency Test;
- 3. Take Fundamental Algebra (MATH 150) at Franklin University; or
- 4. Transfer in Fundamental Algebra (MATH 150) or higher (College Algebra, Calculus, Finite Math, Discrete Math, etc., but not Statistics\*\*)

<sup>\*\*</sup>Statistics will not waive the Algebra Competency Requirement unless the course has been approved for your school. Please see your SSA.

This is a nonstandard bridge course. Completion of this course at your community college may increase the number of University Electives required to meet the 40 hour residency at Franklin.
