In order to address the continuing educational needs of its nursing students, Orange County Community College ("SUNY Orange") enters into an agreement with iDesignEDU, LLC ("iDesign") on behalf of its partner, the New York Institute of Technology ("New York Tech").


New York Tech is committed to creating the most cost-effective and flexible RN to B.S. in Nursing degree in New York, while delivering the highest quality nursing education backed by CCNE accreditation. The new online RN to B.S. in Nursing program launched in November 2020 and allows for nurses to complete their bachelor's degree in as little as twelve months.

With this agreement, New York Tech will offer a preferred tuition rate to graduates from SUNY Orange who are admitted to the program, at a rate of \$8,000 for the 12 core nursing curriculum courses (31 total credit hours for a rate of \$258.06/credit hour). The preferred tuition rate will also be extended to family members of SUNY Orange graduates who hold a valid nursing license and are admitted to the RN to B.S. in Nursing program. This partnership underscores SUNY Orange's commitment to the professional growth and continuing education of its nursing graduates.


SUNY Orange will take no part in the application or admissions process for the RN to B.S. in Nursing program, which will solely be the domain of New York Tech. Additionally, SUNY Orange will not be party to the financial or academic relationship between an admitted or enrolled student and New York Tech regardless of whether that person is a SUNY Orange student or family member of a student. The affiliation agreement between SUNY Orange and New York Tech simply extends the opportunity for a preferred tuition rate to SUNY Orange students or family members of students.

To facilitate access to, and interest in, New York Tech's new RN to B. S. in Nursing program, SUNY Orange agrees to designate a staff member to act as program coordinator to communicate this new partnership internally to students and graduates via email and in-person announcements. In addition, this program coordinator will help facilitate quarterly in-person or digital interactions, where New York Tech representatives can meet prospective students face to face to share information and answer questions.

Upon confirmation of internal communication of the program and partnership, graduates and family members of graduates will have access to the preferred tuition rate. The term of this agreement shall be for one (1) year and shall automatically renew for successive periods of one (1) year, until terminated by either party, with or without cause, upon sixty (60) days prior written notice. Termination of this agreement will not affect the admission status of currently enrolled students.
