Process for Using Educational Benefits:

- Apply and be accepted to SUNY Orange
- Complete the Student Information Form (if not done so already)
- Apply for educational benefits or tuition assistance (if active duty)
- Submit a copy of your DD 214 and Certificate of Eligibility or educational benefits approval to **vetaffairs@sunyorange.edu**
- Request an official copy of your Joint Services Transcript be sent to the Office of Admissions
- Apply for Financial Aid. As a military student, or dependent/spouse of a military service member, you may be entitled to federal or state financial aid, including both grants and loans. To determine this eligibility, you will need to complete a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at www.studentaid.gov. Complete the New York State Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) application, as directed on the FAFSA submission confirmation page, in order to apply for New York State educational benefits.
